

AL Living at Home Waiver

The Alabama Living at Home Waiver (LAH) provides services to adults and children 3 years or older who have a diagnosis of intellectual disabilities who would otherwise qualify for care in an Intermediate Care Facility for Individuals with Intellectual Disabilities.

As the assigned Financial Intermediary, Allied Community Resources is responsible for but not limited to:



- Enrollment with Federal and State entities as a household employer.
- Employment verification/documentation for household employers' employees.
- Assistance with plan management
- Payroll and reimbursements for household employers' employees.
